District Superintendent Scott Moellenberndt opened the meeting with introductions and a welcome to those attending. Superintendent Moellenberndt presented the group with a handout of Epic MRA's Community Survey results with a brief review. He explained the Districts need for direction as it relates to its facilities and community input.

C.F.O. Dan Garno gave a brief history of the Districts approach to facility improvements and the initial process that lead to the fine arts initiative. C.F.O. Garno covered the RFQ/RFP and its relationship to funding options.

Tom Kasefang, Facilities Director, furthered the discussion by covering the Facilities assessment and how it relates to the RFQ/RFP. Kasefang covered the RFQ/RFP timeline, and announced that a district map showing building location and the District's asbestos inventory would be additional information available on line for those interested.

School Board President, Norris Klump spoke of the importance of looking ahead as the State leaders continue to talk of decreasing funding and consolidation of smaller schools districts.

Followed by a short question and answer session, the group was invited to tour the District's buildings beginning with the High School, followed by the Elementary and concluding at the Middle School.
