25-26 Blissfield Community Schools Chromebook Insurance

Blissfield Community Schools issues a Chromebook device and charger to students each year. Middle and high school students are also provided a protective case to transport their device to and from school. Chromebooks are considered curricular material, similar to a textbook, and are required to be brought to class daily. The proper use and care of the Chromebook is the responsibility of the student and their parent/guardian.

BCS, as a self-insurer of all school-owned Chromebook devices, performs all device repairs in-house. Repairs typically fall under two categories: accidental damage and abuse. Typical accidental damage to devices includes cracked screens, broken keyboards, etc. The cost for these repairs can range from approximately \$25 to \$150 per incident. In addition, the cost to replace a damaged, lost or stolen Chromebook can be as high as \$300 including the license and case.

Insurance Cost -

Families have the option of insuring each child's Chromebook against accidental damage of the device for \$35 (per device/student (max \$100 per family)). This optional insurance protects the student's school-issued device against up to two (2) instances of accidental damage as long as the device was in the case when damaged. Abuse damage is handled on a case by case basis determined by the school. Insurance purchases are non-refundable and must be purchased each school year.
